

**JANUARY 2002 CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE**

BILL NO. CLB0226

INTRODUCED BY: Executive Branch of the Crow Tribal Government

BY REQUEST OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBE

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ADOPTING THE CROW TRIBAL BUDGET FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF CROW TRIBAL REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003, ENDING OCTOBER, 2003."

**WHEREAS**, the Crow Tribal Constitution empowers the Legislative Branch of the Crow Tribal Government to grant final approval of a budget for the expenditure of Crow Tribal revenue developed by the Executive Branch; and

**WHEREAS**, a budget for the expenditure of Crow Tribal revenue has been developed by the Executive Branch of the Crow Tribal Government for the fiscal year 2003 commencing in October, 2002 and ending October, 2003 from the following sources of Tribal revenue:

1. General Fund of the Crow Tribe	\$8,060,015
2. 107 <sup>th</sup> Judgement Fund Interest	\$5,471,266
3. Indirect Cost from federal contracts	\$3,355,000

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Branch will present a line item budget for the scheduled legislative hearing to provide the Crow Tribal Legislature with full budget information for all three branches of the Crow Tribal Government.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:


**NEW SECTION. Section 1. Approval of the 2003 fiscal year budget for the expenditure of Crow Tribal revenue.** (1) The 2003 fiscal year budget for the expenditure of Crow Tribal revenues in accordance with the budget developed by the Executive Branch and reviewed and amended by the Legislative Branch is hereby adopted by the Crow Tribal Legislature. Furthermore, any future amendments to the budget, moving funds from one program to another, must be approved by the Crow Tribal Legislature. However, amendments moving funds from one line item to another line item within the same program, only need approval of the program Director and revenue Director.

**NEW SECTION. Section 2.** The Executive and Legislative Branches herein require a reserve of no less than five and one-half per cent (5 ½ %) of the 2003 General Fund Budget for use of special needs as approved by the Executive and Legislative Branches.

All Crow Fair expenditures, whether from the 2003 General Fund or the 107<sup>th</sup> Boundary Settlement Revenues, shall require submission to the Finance Department within established budget categories as set by the Crow Fair Administrator, the Crow Fair Board, and the Executive with final approval by the Legislative Branch.


### CERTIFICATION
