INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE ELOISE PEASE,
VALLEY OF THE CHIEFS DISTRICT

A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AND EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBAL GOVERNMENT TO REQUIRE THE HEALTH AND HUMAN DEPARTMENT TO SEEK AND APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SOURCES IN ORDER TO CONSTRUCTION A YOUTH CENTER IN LODGE GRASS.

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislative and Executive Branch of the Tribal Government acknowledge and agree that the youth who reside in Lodge Grass lack a facility for activities after school hours and during the summer vacation; and


WHEREAS, a youth activity facility would provide the youth with alternatives to drug and alcohol use and the commission of crimes in addition to providing a safe place for youth to gather and socialize instead of on the streets of the Town of Lodge Grass.

BE IT JOINTLY RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AND EXECUTIVE BRANCHES OF THE CROW TRIBE:

That the Executive Branch of the Crow Tribal Government through the Health and Human Services Department shall seek funding, through grant applications to public and private sources to enable the Crow Tribe to provide a youth center for youth activities in the Town of Lodge Grass and that the Heath and Human Serves Department is further ordered to prepare and submit a joint report to the Legislature and Executive Branch regarding its efforts at the April Session.
