JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND
THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH ENTITLED:

**“AUTHORIZATION FOR CROW TRIBAL DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO
PARTICIPATE IN AMBER ALERT PILOT PROGRAM AND TO RECEIVE GRANTS
FROM U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE/OJP FOR SUCH PURPOSE.”**

WHEREAS, THE Crow Nation is committed to improving the safety of its youth members; and

WHEREAS, there is a limited understanding of the AMBER Alert Program as well as the partnerships needed to create an AMBER Alert plan for Tribal communities; and

WHEREAS, AMBER Alert plans require critical partnerships between law enforcement, the broadcast/media industry, department of transportation and other organizations to effectively recover endangered or abducted children; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice’s Office of Justice Programs has announced the AMBER Alert in Indian Country initiative to establish and expand child recovery practices, capacity and resources; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Nation Department of Public Safety will design and develop a plan for activating a local AMBER Alert system, which will include purchasing equipment, training and building inter agency relationships; and

WHEREAS, there will be no Tribal Contribution to cover cost associated with this project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH:


Section 1. That the Crow Nation Department of Public Safety is authorized to participate in the AMBER Alert in Indian Country pilot project administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs; and

Section 2. That the Crow Nation Department of Public Safety is authorized to apply for, receive, and administer grants from the Department of Justice/OJP ranging in amount from \$125,000.00 to \$450,000.00 based on the project needs assessment.

Section 3. That the Crow Tribal Public Safety Department be and hereby is authorized to carry out the intent of this Resolution until fully implemented.

CERTIFICATION


