LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION NO. LR0209

INTRODUCED BY: ROBERT LITTLE LIGHT, VALLEY OF THE GIVEAWAYS DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST AN INVESTIGATION AND POSSIBLE ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST TRESPASSERS WHO MAY UTILIZING TRIBAL TRUST LANDS AND INDIVIDUAL TRUST LANDS WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION IN THE CEDED STRIP.

WHEREAS, there are approximately 4,161 surface acres of Tribal Trust Lands and 11,900 surface acres of Individual Trust Lands situated within the area north of the Crow Indian Reservation commonly referred to as the Ceded Strip;

WHEREAS, possible trespass to the Tribal and Individual Trust Lands may be occurring on the above stated lands; and

WHEREAS, a need exists to conduct an investigation to determine if trespass is occurring on those Trust Lands in the Ceded Strip for possible enforcement and reimbursement for such trespasses.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:

That an investigation on shall be conducted to determine and identify all trespasses to land occurring on Trust Lands in the Ceded Strip for possible enforcement action and reimbursements for any such trespasses.
