A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST BIA SPECIAL OFFICERS TO INVESTIGATE THE INTENTIONAL DESTRUCTION OF THE DANCE HALL FORMERLY LOCATED ON CROW TRIBAL TRUST LAND IN SAINT XAVIER, MONTANA.

WHEREAS, criminal mischief and criminal trespass to tribal lands, whether held in fee or in trust, is a chronic problem throughout the Crow Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the BIA Special Officer and Criminal Investigator be authorized to investigate criminal trespass and criminal mischief and the duty to enforce against such crimes; and


WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch of the Crow Tribe resolves that the BIA Special Officer must be more attentive to the investigation of such crimes and must Criminal Investigate exercise his/her powers of enforcement and prosecution to the fullest extent possible law.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:

That the BIA Special Officer and Criminal Investigator Investigate Criminal Trespass and criminal mischief of Tribal lands held in fee and in trust to the fullest extent possible by law, specifically the intentional destruction of the dance hall formerly located on Tribal trust land in Saint Xavier, Montana, with a report to the Crow Legislature by April 2002.
