## BILL NO. <u>CLB05-11</u>

## INTRODUCED BY CARL E. VENNE, CHAIRMAN CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH

### A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED:

# "AN ACT TO AMEND THE CROW LAW AND ORDER CODE TO PROVIDE PROCEDURES FOR JOINT ACTION RESOLUTIONS"

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Constitution creates three separate branches of government; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution requires that on certain matters the approval of the Legislature is required for actions proposed by the Executive Branch; and

WHEREAS, from time to time there are matters of concern to the Apsaalooke (Crow) Tribe which may benefit from joint approval of the Executive Branch and the Legislative Branch; and

WHEREAS, such matters may not involve the creation or adoption of statutory law which would require amendment of or addition to the Crow Law and Order Code; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Law and Order Code contains in Title 1 the general provisions for the enactment of the general law of the Apsaalooke Nation; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to include in Title 1 the circumstances under which joint action may be taken without amendment to the Crow Law and Order Code; and

WHEREAS, the interests of the Crow Nation will be served by adoption of the following amendments to the Crow Law and Order Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Title 1 of the Crow Law and Order Code is amended as follows:

Chapter 2. Joint Action Resolutions

Part 1. When authorized.

1-2-101. When Authorized. Joint Action Resolutions are authorized when:

- a) the Crow Tribal Constitution requires approval by the Legislature of actions proposed by the Executive Branch
- i) pertinent to the sale, disposition, lease or encumbrance of Tribal lands, interests in lands or mineral assets;
  - ii) to approve or disapprove an annual budget prepared by the Executive Branch; and
- iii) to approve or disapprove limited waivers of sovereign immunity by the Executive Branch of Government when waivers are necessary for business purposes.
  - b) it is in the best interest of the Apsaalooke (Crow) Nation for the Legislative Branch and the Executive Branch to act jointly on a matter which is not an amendment or addition of statutory general law which must be included in the Crow Law and Order Code.

#### Part 2. How Presented.

- 1-2-101 How Presented A joint action resolution may be proposed by the Legislature or the Executive Branch fifteen (15) days prior to a regularly scheduled session of the Legislature.
- 1-2-102. <u>Form of Joint Action Resolution</u>. A Joint Action Resolution will be submitted in writing in substantially the following form:
