# INTRODUCED BY. WYOLA DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES

### JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature is authorized to adopt resolutions for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians, approved by the Secretary of Interior on July 14, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature is aware of the need to provide positive activities for community members in order to strengthen our Crow communities; and

WHEREAS, the Wyola community has requested that a rodeo arena be established in order to provide such positive activities for the Wyola community members; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature determines that it is in the best interest of the Wyola District to establish a Community Rodeo Arena.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE:

THAT, the Crow Tribal Legislature hereby directs the Crow Tribal Executive Branch to work with the Wyola "Mighty Few" Legislative members to secure Tribal lands in close proximity to the Wyola Community Hall for the Rodeo Arena.

FURTHER, the Crow Tribal Legislature request that the Crow Tribal Executive Branch approves the donations of the former Rodeo Arena equipment bucking chutes, Roping chute, gates and panels, from the Edison Real Bird Memorial Rodeo grounds to the Wyola district.

FINALLY, the Crow Tribal Legislature request the appropriate Crow Tribal Agency to take all necessary action to begin building the Rodeo Arena in a timely manner, upon the availability of funds.
