Joint Action Resolution No. <u>JAR05-12</u> INTRODUCED BY CARL E. VENNE, CHAIRMAN CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH

A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION ENTITLED:

"A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF THE CROW TRIBAL GOVERNMENT TO SEEK A GOVERNMENTAL PURPOSE LOAN UTILIZING THE CONOCO RIGHT OF WAY CONSENT PAYMENTS AS COLLATERAL."

WHEREAS, the Continental Oil Company, later known as the Conoco Oil Company obtained a right of way across Crow Tribal lands in 1963 from the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, 1,627 barrels of gasoline spilled from a break in the Conoco Seminoe Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians filed suit in 1999 against the Conoco Oil Company for damages to Crow Tribal lands from the 1997 oil spill; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians entered into a settlement agreement with the Conoco Oil Company in the year 2000 that included payment to the Tribe of \$1,000,000 per year for the Crow Tribe's consent to a right-of-way across 18 miles of Crow Tribal trust lands for the Conoco Seminoe Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the settlement agreement requires Conoco Oil Company to pay the Crow Tribe \$1,000,000 per year for a period of fifty years commencing in 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians desires to obtain a governmental purpose loan utilizing the Conoco right-of-way consent payments as collateral; and

WHEREAS, the Executive and Legislative Branches of the Crow Tribal Government have determined that a governmental purpose loan would provide the Crow Tribe sufficient capital to pursue governmental purposes to serve the best interests of the Crow Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF GOVERNMENT THAT:

1. The Crow Tribal Government seek a governmental purpose loan from a financial institution utilizing the Conoco Oil Company future payments as collateral.

2. The terms of the loan and the purposes for which it will be expended shall be subject to further approval by the Legislature.
