JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION NO. JAR06-11

INTRODUCED BY THE CROW EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND THE CROW LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE ENTITLED:

"A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY RESCINDING CLB 06-05, AMENDMENTS TO THE CROW LAW AND ORDER CODE, JUVENILES AND DOMESTIC RELATIONS."

WHEREAS, both branches of the Crow tribal government seek to quickly but thoughtfully resolve current disputes regarding the budget, recent legislation and procedural problems;

WHEREAS, both branches of government represent citizens of the Crow Nation, in different but sometimes overlapping capacities, and seek to better the lives of all Crow people;

WHEREAS, both branches of government desire to draft, adopt and implement legislation without violating provisions of the 2001 Crow Constitution;

WHEREAS, both branches of government desire to resolve their differences by negotiation and compromise in order to avoid protracted and expensive litigation in Crow Tribal Court as well as prevent a potential shutdown of Crow governmental operations;

WHEREAS, both branches of government desire to put aside their differences in order to continue making progress toward economic development, governmental stability, protection of Crow Indian children, and create transparency of fiscal management of the Crow tribal budget.

WHEREAS, The Executive Branch and the Legislative Branch of the Crow Tribal government have executed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on August 3, 2006 that contains terms and conditions which if accomplished will settle the difference between the Branches.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:

THAT, without setting precedent and further subject to the terms and conditions of this Resolution and the MOA, both the Legislative Branch and the Executive Branch of the Crow government hereby declare that CLB 06-05, AMENDMENTS TO THE CROW LAW AND ORDER CODE, JUVENILES AND DOMESTIC RELATIONS, is by this action hereby rescinded;

FURTHER, by this action, without setting precedent and further subject to the terms and conditions of this Resolution and the MOA, due to constitutional ambiguities, the Legislature hereby declares null and void the legal position of the Crow Tribal Legislature that inaction by the Crow Tribal Executive Branch concerning CLB 06-05, AMENDMENTS TO THE CROW LAW AND ORDER CODE, JUVENILES AND DOMESTIC RELATIONS, constitutes a veto; provided that such ambiguity concerning vetoes and overrides shall be resolved by Legislation in Bill Form that shall be codified in the October 2006 Crow legislative session;

FURTHER, CLB 06-05, AMENDMENTS TO THE CROW LAW AND ORDER CODE, JUVENILES AND DOMESTIC RELATIONS, shall be redrafted, referred to the appropriate Crow legislative subcommittees for substantive revisions that are consistent with comments provided by the Crow Legal Department on July 21, 2006, and prepared for the October 2006 Crow legislative session;

FURTHER, the Crow Legal Department, on behalf of the Crow Tribal Executive Branch, shall submit (re)drafts of CLB 06-04, CLB 06-05 and veto & override legislation by September 11, 2006, to the Crow Tribal Legislature and incorporate all of the aforementioned contained in the MOA; and if such legislation is not submitted by that date, the parties to this MOA shall return to their respective positions that existed immediately prior to the MOA;

FINALLY, in the August 10, 2006 Special Session, each agenda item must be satisfactorily completed as agreed upon, including passage of the entire budget, otherwise each party may exercise its independent right to withdraw from the MOA prior to adjournment of the special session.
