## APRIL 2007 CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION NO. <u>07-02</u>

### INTRODUCED BY: THE MIGHTY FEW DISTRICT LEGISLATORS J.D. STONE, BEVERLY SHANE, DANA WILSON

A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO RESERVE CROW TRIBAL LAND TO THE MIGHTY FEW DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSES OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT."

WHEREAS, The Crow Tribal Legislature is authorized to adopt resolutions for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians, pursuant to Article V, Section 2 (a), of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 3 (f), of the constitution, the Executive Branch has the power and responsibility to approve or prevent any sale, disposition, lease or encumbrance of Tribal lands, interests in lands or other Tribal assets, with final approval granted by the Legislative Branch, and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe wishes to support the health and improvement of the Districts on the Crow Reservation and has awarded funds in the amount of two hundred thousand (\$200,000.00) dollars to each of the (6) districts to improve and serve the District population, and

WHEREAS, the Mighty Few District Legislators wish to reserve tribal land in the community for the purpose of certain construction projects that well serve the district population.

### NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLTURE;

**THAT**, tribal tract #T-322-A, generally found in the N1/2, SE1/4, SEC.22, T8S, R35 E, an 80 acre tract located near the town of Wyola is hereby reserved, in perpetuity together with all rights, privileges and appurtenances excluding the use of all minerals and water for commercial purposes, to the Mighty Few District as a whole by the Crow Tribe for the purposes of development and construction projects the community chooses to place there.

**FURTHER**, pursuant to section 5 of the Act of June 4<sup>th</sup> 1920, "The Crow Act" up to Eighty Acres in each District may be reserved by the Crow Tribe as recreational grounds for the common use of the Crow Tribe.

FINALLY, that rules for the use of the recreational grounds such as; community center, community park, dance arbor, and other development projects the community chooses to place there will be overseen by the Mighty Few District Legislators, Rodeo committee and Culture Committee.

### **CERTIFICATION**
