INTRODUCED BY CARL E. VENNE, CHAIRMAN CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH

JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH ENTITLED:

"FINAL APPROVAL OF THE OIL AND GAS LEASE BETWEEN THE CROW TRIBE OF INDIANS AND URSA MAJOR (CROW OG), LLC"

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Executive Branch has authority and responsibility pursuant to the "enumerated powers" in Article IV, Section 3(f) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians to "negotiate and approve or prevent any sale, disposition, lease or encumbrance of Tribal lands, interests in lands or other Tribal assets, including buffalo, minerals, gas and oil with final approval granted by the Legislative Branch," and in Article IV Section 3(k) to "negotiate and approve limited waivers of sovereign immunity when such a waiver is necessary for business purposes in accordance with Article V, Section 2(f) of [the] Constitution;" and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Executive Branch, with the delegated assistance of the Oil and Gas Committee headed by the Vice-Secretary of the Executive Branch, has negotiated an Oil and Gas Lease Between the Crow Tribe of Indians and Ursa Major (Crow OG), LLC (the "Lease"), for the exploration and production of oil and gas, including coalbed methane, on approximately 90,000 Tribally-owned net mineral acres in the southeastern corner of the Crow Reservation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch has authority and responsibility pursuant to its "powers and duties" in Article V, Section 2(d) of the Constitution "to grant final approval or disapproval of items negotiated by the Executive Branch of Government pertinent to the sale, disposition, lease or encumbrance of Tribal lands, interests in lands or mineral assets," and in Article V, Section 2(f) to "grant final approval or disapproval of limited waivers of sovereign immunity by the Executive Branch when waivers are necessary for business purposes;" and

WHEREAS, exploration for and development of Tribal oil and gas resources, including coalbed methane, is in the best interests of the Tribe and Tribal members, and the Lease provides for such exploration and development on a fair, environmentally responsible, and commercially sound basis, and the limited waiver of the Tribe's sovereign immunity in the Lease is necessary for business purposes; and

WHEREAS, after approval by the Legislature and Executive Branches of the Crow Tribe, the Lease is subject to approval by the Secretary of the Interior or his designee, pursuant to the Indian Mineral Development Act of 1982 (25 U.S.C. § 2101, *et seq.*) and other applicable Federal law;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE AND THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBE:

Section 1. That the "Oil and Gas Lease Between the Crow Tribe of Indians and Ursa Major (Crow OG), LLC," including the limited waiver of sovereign immunity contained therein, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference, is hereby granted final approval pursuant to Article V, Sections 2(d) and 2(f) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe.

Section 2. That the Chairman of the Executive Branch is authorized to sign and execute the above-referenced Lease on behalf of the Crow Tribe, and to take all such further actions on behalf of the Crow Tribe as are necessary to implement, administer and enforce the Lease.

Section 3. That the final approval granted herein is effective on the date of approval of this Resolution, and is subject only to such further approvals as are required by Federal law.

Section 4. That the Executive Branch will keep the Legislature and/or its designated Subcommittee(s) informed on a timely basis of formal notices issued pursuant to the Lease and other significant actions taken to administer the Lease, including but not limited to the water management plan and any proposed assignment, sublease or transfer; and all amendments to the Lease shall be subject to the further final approval of the Legislature.

Section 5. That no monies shall be expended or drawn against amounts due the Crow Tribe under the Lease until after final approval of the Lease by the Secretary of the Interior or his designee.

Section 6. That prior to final approval of the Lease by the Secretary, the Tribal Executive Branch shall prepare a budget and financial management plan for expenditure of the Lease Bonus which shall be subject to approval of the Crow Tribal Legislature pursuant to its budget approval power under Article V, Section 2(e) of the Tribal Constitution, and all expenditures from such approved budget for the Lease Bonus shall be reported to the Legislature.
