# OCTOBER 2008 CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION No. JAR <u>08-09</u>

INTRODUCED BY CHAIRMAN CARL E. VENNE AND BY SENATOR SIDNEY FITZPATRICK, CENTER LODGE DISTRICT

A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH ENTITLED:

"A JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION (JAR) TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND ITS AGENCIES, AND THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH AND ITS COMMITTEES, TO WORK TOGETHER AND DEVELOP LEGISLATION ENACTING LAWS TO REGULATE ALL ENUMERATED ACTIVITIES CONCERNING CROW (APSÁALOOKE) NATION TREATY LANDS, WHICH LANDS BEING ALL THAT LAND EXISTING WITHIN THE EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES OF THE CROW RESERVATION, INCLUDING ANY LANDS SITUATED OUTSIDE THE EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES WHERE THE CROW (APSÁALOOKE) NATION HOLDS ANY LEGAL OR OTHER REAL PROPERTY INTERESTS; AND SPECIFICALLY, TO DEVELOP THE APSÁALOOKE LAND MANAGEMENT ACT, TO INCLUDE A CROW (APSÁALOOKE) LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT PLAN, A CROW (APSÁALOOKE) LAND USE CODE, AND A CROW (APSÁALOOKE) LAND REGISTRY."

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2 of the Constitution, and the Crow Law and Order Code of the Crow Tribe of Indians authorize the Legislative Branch to promulgate and adopt laws, resolutions, ordinances, codes, regulations and guidelines in accordance with the Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 3(j) of the Constitution authorizes the Executive Branch to protect and preserve the property, wildlife, and natural resources, including air and water, of the Crow lands in accordance with legislation approved by the Legislative Branch; and,

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe does not currently have laws to effect a land and natural resources management plan, a land use code, nor a land registry; and, the otherwise applicable federal and state laws do not fully protect the land, resources, and the unique cultural, linguistic and spiritual values of the Crow Tribe;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Crow Tribal Legislature: That the Crow Tribal Legislature and the Crow Tribal Executive Branch hereby authorize and direct Tribal departments, agencies, offices and legislative committees to develop legislation to enact a land and natural resources plan, a land use code and a land registry office; where such legislation will be introduced to the Legislature for its earliest consideration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Surface Land Subcommittee members shall solicit input from their constituents at district meetings and comments received shall be presented to the Surface Land Subcommittee.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that public hearings shall be held on any draft legislation authorized under this JAR before being presented to the full Legislative Branch for vote.
