A Joint Action Resolution of the Crow Tribe Titled:

# A Joint Action Resolution to Establish a Crow Tribal Junk Vehicle Abatement Program

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") is vested with the power and duty to promulgate and adopt laws, resolutions, ordinances, codes, regulations, and guidelines in accordance with the 2001 Crow Constitution and federal laws; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Executive Branch (hereinafter "Executive Branch") has authority and responsibility pursuant to Article IV, Section 4(a) of the 2001 Constitution to implement all laws, resolutions, codes and policies duly adopted by the Legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, the Crow Tribal Government finds that junk vehicles pose a health and safety hazard and should be considered a public nuisance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Branch Chairman and the Legislature now seek to establish a junk vehicle abatement program to be administered by the Executive Branch pursuant to this resolution and in a manner that is consistent with the 2001 Constitution.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBE:

## Section 1. Policy and Intent.

It shall be the policy of the Crow Tribe to consider any junk vehicles located on the Crow Indian Reservation to be a public nuisance, particularly any junk vehicles located on or along a public roadway or tribal roadway and which either impede traffic, obstruct or hinder efforts at maintaining roadways, or which otherwise create unsightly or unsanitary conditions. The intent of this tribal resolution is to establish a lawful means by which the problem of junk vehicles can be addressed effectively and efficiently in a manner that respects private property rights.

### Section 2. Definitions.

"Incentive program" means the Junk Vehicle Abatement Incentive Program as established pursuant to Section 4 of this resolution.

"Junk vehicle" means a motor vehicle in a state of disrepair that is discarded or appears discarded and is rendered inoperative or incapable of being driven without major repair work.

"Junk vehicle abatement program" means a program established by the Executive Branch pursuant to this resolution which identifies problematic areas associated with junk vehicles and establishes a policy in which the Executive Branch, and its agencies and departments, may take efforts to correct such problems.

"Public street" means any roadway located on the Crow Reservation which serves any residential, governmental, or business area and which has a public right-of-way or easement.

"Regulatory program" means the Junk Vehicle Abatement Regulatory Program as established pursuant to Section 3 of this resolution.

"Tribal roadway" means a roadway located on Crow tribal land or otherwise under the jurisdiction of the Crow Tribe and open to tribal travel or tribally-permitted public travel.

#### Section 3. Junk Vehicle Abatement Regulatory Program.

#### (a) Regulatory program.

The Executive Branch may take all necessary and proper measures, in accordance with this resolution, the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution, and any other applicable tribal law, to forcibly remove all junk vehicles from any public street or tribal roadway on any lands subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Crow Tribe. The Executive Branch may authorize the appropriate Crow tribal agencies or departments to carry out such enforcement efforts.

The Executive Branch may enter into written agreements with any person, governmental entity, including but not limited to the Crow Tribal Housing Authority, or business for the purpose of establishing cooperative efforts in order to facilitate the implementation of this resolution and the regulatory program. *Provided that*, no such agreement shall be construed as a limited waiver of the Crow Tribe's sovereign immunity.

#### (b) Budget amendments.

In order to make expenditure of funds within the control of the Crow Tribe for the purpose of supporting the regulatory program, the Executive Branch shall comply with all provisions of any applicable Crow tribal law and federal law.

#### (c) Public notice.

The Executive Branch shall give adequate public notice prior to the regulatory program taking effect. Public notice shall be no less than fourteen (14) calendar days.

## (d) Regulatory program a tribal public document.

The regulatory program, in its entirety, shall be available for inspection and copy by any person subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Crow Tribe. The Executive Branch may establish a reasonable fee for providing copies to a member of the public.

#### Section 4. Junk Vehicle Abatement Incentive Program.

#### (a) Incentive program.

The Executive Branch may take all necessary and proper measures, in accordance with this resolution, the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution, and any other applicable tribal law, to assist property owners in the removal of all junk vehicles from any public street, tribal roadway, or other lands subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Crow Tribe. The Executive Branch may authorize the appropriate Crow tribal agencies or departments to carry out such assistance efforts.

The Executive Branch may enter into written agreements with any person, governmental entity, including but not limited to the Crow Tribal Housing Authority, or business for the purpose of establishing cooperative efforts in order to facilitate the implementation of this resolution and the incentive program. *Provided that*, no such agreement shall be construed as a limited waiver of the Crow Tribe's sovereign immunity.

# (b) Budget amendments.

In order to make expenditure of funds within the control of the Crow Tribe for the purpose of supporting the incentive program, the Executive Branch shall comply with all provisions of any applicable Crow tribal law and federal law.

#### (c) Public notice.

The Executive Branch shall give adequate public notice prior to the incentive program taking effect. Public notice shall be no less than fourteen (14) calendar days.

(d) Incentive program a tribal public document.

The incentive program, in its entirety, shall be available for inspection and copy by any person subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Crow Tribe. The Executive Branch may establish a reasonable fee for providing copies to a member of the public.

#### Section 5. Effective Date.

This resolution shall become effective upon being duly adopted by the Crow Tribal Legislature and signed into law by the Chairman of the Executive Branch.
