INTRODUCED BY DARRIN OLD COYOTE, CHAIRMAN

JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND THE
CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH ENTITLED:

**“RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF ‘DOT GOV’ DOMAIN NAME
FOR THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH WEBSITE.”**

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Government wishes to obtain a domain name for its Tribal Website that is befitting the Tribe’s identity as a native sovereign nation; and

WHEREAS, the General Services Administration administers the registration of “dot gov” domain names, has designated “_____ - nsn.gov” for Tribal Websites, and requires a Tribal Resolution in order to assign such domain name to a Tribal Government; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has authority and responsibility pursuant to the “enumerated powers” in Article IV, Section 3(a) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians to represent the Crow Tribe in negotiations with Federal, State and local governments in matters of welfare, education, and economic development, and the “general duties” in Section 4 to “implement all laws, resolutions, codes and policies duly adopted by the Legislative Branch;” and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch has authority and responsibility pursuant to its “powers and duties” in Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution to “promulgate and adopt laws, resolutions, ordinances, codes regulations and guidelines” for the governance of the Crow Tribe;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE
AND THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH:**

Section 1. That the Tribal Executive Branch is hereby authorized to take such actions as are necessary to obtain registration of a “DOT GOV” domain name and administer the Crow Tribal Government’s official Website at “Crow-nsn.gov”.

Section 2. That the Crow Tribal Legislature and Crow Tribal Judicial Branch shall be authorized, at their election, to utilize the “DOT GOV” domain under such terms and conditions as provided for in a memorandum of agreement with the Executive Branch.


Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect on the date of approval by the Legislative Branch and the Chairman of the Executive Branch.

Section 4. [Reserved for ethical standards governing the “DOT GOV” domain.]






