LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION NO. <u>LR07-06</u>

INTRODUCED BY THE CROW LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

A LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE ENTITLED:

"ESTABLISHING OF AMENDMENT TO THE RULES OF ORDER, RULE 8
DEFINING THE LEGAL REQUIREMENT FOR A "TWO THIRDS VOTE" OF THE
LEGISLATURE."

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature is authorized to adopt resolutions, regulations and guidelines for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal legislature approved Rules of Order to provide for orderly and efficient Legislative sessions, and

WHEREAS: Rule 8 in the Legislative Rules of Order reads as follows: "Thirteen members of the Legislature, twelve members plus the Speaker (or Speaker Pro Tem in the Speaker's absence) shall constitute a quorum upon the establishment of which the Legislature may call the Legislative Session to order. Once a quorum is established, the Legislature may continue to conduct business as long as a majority of the full membership of the Legislature is present. However, the Legislature may not vote on any matter until a quorum of thirteen members is present."

WHEREAS, upon working with the Rules of Order, the Crow Legislature has determined there is a need to define what legally constitutes a legal two thirds vote by the Crow Legislative body, and

WHEREAS: the Crow Legislature hereby finds it necessary to amend the Rules of Order, specifically Rule 8.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

RULE 8 OF THE LEGISLATURE'S RULES OF ORDER IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

A TWO THIRDS VOTE OF THE CROW LEGISLATURE IS HEREBY LEGALLY DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:
