A LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE
ENTITLED:

**“A LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION TO ADOPT GUIDELINES FOR CELL PHONE
USE ASSIGNED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATIVE BRANCH”**

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature is authorized to adopt resolutions, regulations and guidelines for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal legislature approved the purchase of cell phones for the Legislative Senators and Legislative staff members, and

WHEREAS: the Crow Legislature in Regular Session determined that it is appropriate, necessary and proper to purchase cell phones for its Senators and staff with the following policy and agreement for use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT THE FOLLOWING POLICY SHALL APPLY FOR CELL PHONE USE.

Cell Phone Policy

Cell phones will be assigned to members of the Legislative Branch and its employees are the property of the Crow Legislative Branch.


Prior to the assignment of a cell phone to the Legislator, or the Legislative Employee, shall sign and agree to the terms and conditions for the use of the cell phone.

Loss, stolen or damaged cell phones that are not insured will be the responsibility of the user. Payment of the deductible will the responsibility of the user.

A Legislator who is not re-elected shall return the cell phone to the Legislative Office 2 weeks prior to the end of his/her term. If the cell phone is not returned, or damaged upon being returned, the cost of the cell phone will be deducted from the last paycheck of the Legislator it was assigned to and will be used toward the purchase of a new cell phone for the newly elected Legislator.


CERTIFICATION





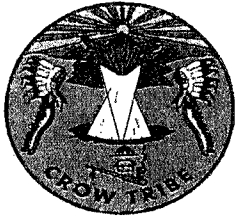
