"To Make the Position of Law Clerk Permanent"

**LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE APPROVING AND
ADOPTING A POLICY FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH**

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature is a separate and distinct branch of government under the 2001 Constitution of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature is authorized to adopt resolutions, regulations and guidelines for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on July 14, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature requires technical and professional support in the exercise of its constitutional authorities, including legal research and preparation of legal documents; and

WHEREAS, the position of "temporary law clerk" in cooperation with the Speaker of the House was established for a period of 90 days by consensus of the Personnel and Revenue Committees on November 3, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the 90-day "temporary law clerk" position began on November 16, 2009 and is scheduled to conclude on February 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature has determined that it is necessary and proper to extend the "temporary law clerk" position beyond February 16, 2009 as a permanent position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE:

THAT, the position of "temporary law clerk" is hereby made permanent as a legislative employee in the legal office of the Crow Tribal Legislature with the job description, salary, and benefits determined by established Legislative Branch policies.

FURTHER, that nothing contained in this Resolution may be construed to limit the authority of the Crow Tribal Legislature to eliminate the position of law clerk in the future.

FINALLY, the action directed herein shall take effect immediately upon approval by majority vote the Crow Tribal Legislature and the Legislature directs that the Legislative Branch Speaker and staff take all necessary actions to enact this policy.


CERTIFICATION




