## A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE TO CONFIRM NOMINATIONS TO THE CROW TRIBAL EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS COMMISSION

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") has the power and duty under Article V, Section 2 of the 2001 Crow Constitution to promulgate and adopt resolutions in accordance with the 2001 Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Employment Rights Commission (hereinafter "Commission") is an independent rule-making and adjudicatory commission of the Crow Tribe established through the 2009 Crow Nation Workforce Protection Act (CLB No. 09-01, as amended), and consisting of seven individuals representing the six Districts and one at-large with qualifications and duties as provided for in Title 17, Chapter 2 of the Crow Law and Order Code; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has the lawful authority to confirm nominations made by the Crow Tribal Chairman to the Commission, pursuant to the terms of the Workforce Protection Act; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Darrin Old Coyote has submitted a letter of nomination for the Commission to the Legislature for review and confirmation; and

WHEREAS, each legislative District delegation has given written concurrence to the Tribal Chairman's nominations as provided for in the Legislative Branch Rules of Order; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Committee held confirmation hearings on the record and by motion has officially recommended confirmation by the full Legislature of the Commission nominations; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative and in the best interests of the Crow Tribe to ensure a fully-functional Tribal Employment Rights Office, including a duly-constituted Commission able to promulgate administrative regulations and conduct hearings in accordance with the Workforce Protection Act.

That these confirmations shall become effective immediately upon this tribal resolution being duly adopted by the Legislature and an administration of an oath of office by the Speaker of the House or his designee.

#### BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED:

That the terms of the members of the Crow Tribal Employment Rights Office Commission shall commence on the effective date of this tribal resolution and shall end on the same day in 2016.
