A Legislative Resolution Titled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE TO CONFIRM HEATHER CORSON AS THE APPELLATE COURT JUDGE

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") has the power and duty under Article V, Section 2(a) of the Crow Tribal Constitution to promulgate and adopt resolutions in accordance with the Tribal Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article X of the Crow Tribal Constitution the Crow Tribal Judicial Branch of Government shall consist of all courts established by the Crow Law and Order Code; and

WHEREAS, Title 3-3-308 of the Law and Order Code provides that the highest court of the Crow Nation is the Crow Court of Appeals, which is presided over by the Appellate Court Judge, who serves a four-year term and must be a professional attorney licensed to practice law in any of the 50 states and who is nominated by the Chief Judge of the Crow Tribal Court within 60 days of a vacancy or thereafter by the Tribal Chairman, and subject to confirmation by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Darrin Old Coyote nominated Heather Corson as the Appellate Judge to fill a vacancy which has existed since February 2011; and

WHEREAS, on September 11th, 2013 the Judicial Committee held a confirmation hearing and voted 8-0 to forward the nomination to the full Legislature with a recommendation for confirmation; and

WHEREAS, Heather Corson is a member of the Montana state bar, an experienced attorney with judicial experience, an enrolled Crow tribal member and, accordingly, is well-qualified for the position of Appellate Judge of the Crow Court of Appeals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE IN SPECIAL SESSION:

That Heather Corson is duly confirmed as the Appellate Judge of the Crow Court of Appeals and shall have all powers and duties associated with such office of Crow Tribal Government. The four-year term shall commence immediately upon the effective date of this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED:

That this confirmation resolution shall become effective immediately upon being duly adopted by the Legislature and an administration of an oath of office by the Speaker of the House, or his designee.
