A Legislative Resolution Titled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE TO CALL UPON THE ARROW CREEK DISTRICT TO ESTABLISH A NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAM

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Crow Tribal Constitution vests the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") with the power and duty to promulgate and adopt resolutions in accordance with the Crow Tribal Constitution and federal law for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Arrow Creek District of the Crow Indian Reservation includes exits from the west entrance from Montana Highway 19, St. Xavier Road and Edgar Road to Cottonwood Creek Road and is situated between South Pryor Creek Road to the Pryor Mountains; and, also include areas along North Pryor Creek Road and Blue Creek Road to Billings, Montana and South from Blue Creek Road, Cormier Road to the Crow Reservation line, all of which are areas of high traffic in and out of this District; and

WHEREAS, the large amount of traffic in the Arrow Creek District increases the potential for local drug distribution, theft, burglaries, driving under the influence, and other potential crimes; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of an organized neighborhood watch by local citizens of the Arrow Creek District will improve the ability of law enforcement to respond to criminal activity in a timely and effective manner and its local presence should serve to deter criminal activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE IN REGULAR SESSION:

That, the Legislature call upon and support efforts by the Arrow Creek District Senators to establish a local neighborhood watch program for the communities of the Arrow Creek District. The Arrow Creek District Senators support the procedures of the Bureau of Justice Assistance Neighborhood Watch Manual, attached as Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Tribal Secretary is hereby respectfully requested to take all measures necessary and proper to ensure an expedited nonprofit incorporation of an Arrow Creek District Neighborhood Watch Program through the filing of organizational documents in accordance with Title 18 of the Crow Law and Order Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

Agencies and departments of Crow Tribal law enforcement with lawful jurisdiction in the Arrow Creek District shall be called upon to support in the development and implementation of the Arrow Creek District Neighborhood Watch Program.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED:

This Legislative Resolution take effect immediately upon becoming duly adopted by the Legislature.
