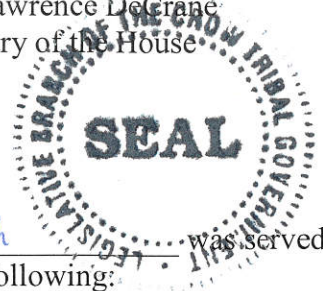



**JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION No. 17-22**

INTRODUCED BY ALVIN NOT AFRAID, JR., CHAIRMAN  
CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH

JOINT ACTION RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE AND THE  
CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH ENTITLED:

**“A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING LITTLE BIG HORN COLLEGE AS THE  
APSAALOOKE EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH CENTER.”**

Legislative Findings:

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of Crow Tribal Constitution the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter “Legislature”) has the power and duty to promulgate and adopt laws and resolutions in accordance with this Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians and for providing for the exclusion of persons not legally entitled to reside or remain within the exterior boundaries of the Crow Indian Reservation; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 4(a) of the Crow Tribal Constitution, the Executive Branch has the general duty to the implement all laws, resolutions, codes, and policies duly adopted by the Legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Big Horn College (LBHC) is chartered by the Crow Tribe as the Tribal College for the Crow Nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the mission of (LBHC) is to support the professional, vocational and personal development of individual students for their advancement in higher education or the workplace and inspiring Crow and American Indian Scholarship; and

**WHEREAS**, the goal of LBHC’s research policy is to strengthen LBHC research activities to address issues of importance to the Crow Tribe and support the College’s core themes: (1) access to educational and training opportunities; (2) commitment to community education and outreach; and (3) dedication to the enhancement of the Crow culture and language, by placing an increased emphasis on student research, the college educates undergraduate students not only to be consumers of knowledge, but producers of knowledge; and



**WHEREAS**, the objectives of LBHC's research policy are that: (1) students will learn to conduct research by engaging with faculty, staff and the Crow community in local research projects and/or by participating in opportunities to conduct summer research with universities; (2) local research projects will address issues meaningful to our community, and when appropriate, will be conducted following the principles of community-based participatory research (CBPR). Students and their mentors will present research results to the Crow community through an LBHC open house and will provide research results to the LBHC library/archives for community access; and (3) the appropriate incorporation of Crow culture and/or language will be considered in designing research projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the President of LBHC reviews and ensures the ethics and appropriateness of all research carried out by the College, especially with regards to the participation of Crow community members, the engagement of the community as appropriate and the relevant and ethical incorporation of Crow history and culture; and

**WHEREAS**, LBHC has had and continues to have a successful undergraduate research program over the past fifteen years addressing diverse topics from Crow culture and history to health, natural resources, water quality and other issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the President of LBHC, with appropriate administrator(s), faculty, staff and students, offers to meet annually with the Crow Tribal Administration and with the Crow Tribal Legislature to present and discuss results of the year's research; and

**WHEREAS**, these annual presentations will be archived with the LBHC library for community access; and

**WHEREAS**, the Crow Tribal Administration and the Crow Tribal Legislature are invited to inform (LBHC) of local issues for which research might help provide better understanding and potential solutions, and the College agrees to look into whether appropriate people and funding sources can be found to conduct such research with the inclusion of LBHC students. **NOW,**

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED IN REGULAR SESSION**

**Section 1.** That the Crow Tribal Administration and the Crow Tribal Legislature support the LBHC's Mission and Research Policy by designating LBHC as the Educational Research Center for the Crow Tribe of Indians pursuant to the Crow Tribe's IRRB laws and policies including federal requirements. Attached to this JAR will be a list of subject matter areas in which designates LBHC as the research center.

**Section 2.** In the event the event any other Crow Tribal entities seek to complete the same research activities, the tribal entity and LBHC may work together or designate the lead authority for the purpose of alleviating duplication of activities and sharing resources; provided, that any such relationship shall be established by an agreement in writing consistent with section 1 above.


**Section 3.** That the approval granted herein is effective on the date of approval of this Resolution.
