A Legislative Resolution Titled

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE TO RECOGNIZE AND
RATIFY THE APSAALOOKE NATION HOUSING AUTHORITY'S PERSONNEL
POLICY, ATTACHMENT F: ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE POLICY**

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") has the power and duty under Article V, Section 2 of the Crow Tribal Constitution to promulgate and adopt laws, resolutions and guidelines in accordance with the Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has the constitutional authority to provide for the establishment of rules and policies in its review of proposed legislation and other matters requiring legislative action; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Government created CLB 17-03, An Act to Repeal and Replace the Crow Tribal Housing Ordinance, which created a Housing Board of Commissioners which governs the Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority (hereinafter ANHA). The Apsaalooke Nation Housing Board of Commissioners was delegated administrative rule-making authority to create rules and regulations governing activities of the Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, The Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority met with the Legislative Branch Infrastructure Committee for review and analysis of the Personnel Policy of the ANHA for the Personnel Policy, Attachment F: Drug and Controlled Substance Policy to provide a safe working environment for its employees. The Infrastructure Committee held a vote May 22, 2018 to send the policy to the floor and a recommendation for approval; and

WHEREAS, 19-2-108, states all administrative rules shall be published with adequate public notice under written Executive Branch policy as a proposed rule at least thirty (30) days prior to taking effect. The Secretary of the Legislature shall be served with a certified copy simultaneous to public notice. The Legislature shall have the authority to approve or disapprove, without amendment, by legislative resolution. Upon approval by the Legislature or in the event no action is taken by the legislature within thirty (30) days, the proposed rule shall become a finale enforceable rule

WHEREAS, such rules and regulations adopted by the ANHA are subject to ratification through Legislative Resolution.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL
LEGISLATURE IN SPECIAL SESSION:**

Section 1. that the Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority Personnel Policy, Attachment F: Alcohol and Controlled Substance Policy, attached hereto and incorporated by reference is hereby ratified.

Section 2. This Legislative Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval and the Alcohol and Controlled Substance Policy shall be valid and enforceable.


