A Legislative Resolution titled

**AN ACT APPROVING AND SUPPORTING SUBMISSION OF A FISCAL YEAR 2019
INDIAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION ON
BEHALF OF THE APSAALOOKE NATION HOUSING AUTHORITY A TRIBALLY
DESIGNATED HOUSING ENTITY (TDHE) PURSUANT TO CROW TRIBAL
HOUSING ORDINANCE CLB 17-03**

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter “Legislature”) has the power and duty under Article V, Section 2(a) of the Crow Tribal Constitution to promulgate and adopt laws, resolutions and guidelines in accordance with the Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has the general duty under Article IV, Section 4 of the Crow Tribal Constitution to implement all laws, resolutions and policies duly adopted by Legislature; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of section 19-10-102, the Housing Ordinance anticipates the Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority (ANHA) the authority, in cooperation with the Executive Branch can apply for additional funding to support the needs of the Apsaalooke people, and the ANHA is preparing a Fiscal Year 2019 Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) application as a Tribal Organization on behalf of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, ANHA has identified the need to complete substantial rehabilitation on 30 existing housing units to extend the life of these units and be certain they meet reasonable habitability standards and is applying to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for an ICDBG grant for the purpose of rehabilitating these 30 low-income housing units; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Executive Branch and Legislature desire to authorize and support the proposed 2019 ICDBG application to rehabilitate low-income housing units.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATIVE
BRANCHES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Crow Tribe hereby authorizes, approves and supports the Board of Commissioners of the Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority to submit the attached Fiscal Year 2019 Indian Community Development Block Grant Application on behalf of the Crow Tribe


Section 2. If the application is funded, the expenditure of funds thereunder by the Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority are specifically authorized as an addendum to the Crow Tribal fiscal year 2019 budget, in an amount identified in the grant award and grant documents.

Section 3. Apsaalooke Nation Housing Authority Board of Commissioners packet enclosure, is attached as "Exhibit A"

Section 4. Effective Date. This Legislative Resolution shall take effect upon its enactment by the Crow Tribal Legislature in accordance with the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution.


