A Legislative Resolution of the Crow Tribal Legislature titled

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISTATURE TO ENGAGE WITH BARNET B. SKELTON, JR. P.C., BANKRUPTCY COUNSEL, TO REPRESENT THE CROW TRIBE'S INTEREST THROUGH THE CROW LEGISLATURE

Statement of Legislative Findings:

- WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislative Branch (hereinafter "Legislature") has the power and duty pursuant to Article V, Section 2(c) and (e) of the Crow Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, a significant amount of severance tax and lease income is derived from coal leases with Westmoreland Resources Incorporated ("Westmoreland"); and
- **WHEREAS**, Westmoreland has entered bankruptcy in Federal Bankruptcy court in Houston, Texas; and
- **WHEREAS**, Westmoreland entering bankruptcy significantly impacts the future of the Crow Tribe as it impinges Crow lands and threatens Crow jobs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Crow Executive Branch has relied solely upon the Department of Interior to represent its interests in Bankruptcy Court; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Crow Tribe no longer has legal representation from the Executive Branch, and the Westmoreland bankruptcy is fast-tracked with deadlines threatening Crow sovereignty quickly approaching; and
- WHEREAS, the Crow Legislature has determined it cannot carry out its Constitutional obligations and duties to approve or disapprove any Westmoreland business without more information; and
- WHEREAS, the Crow Legislature has determined the most effective way to gather that information is to hire a bankruptcy specialist with specific experience in Indian Country law and bankruptcies involving such; and
- WHEREAS, Barnet B. Skelton, bankruptcy attorney from Houston, Texas, is familiar with the bankruptcy and the current state of affairs at Crow Tribe, including the leases between Westmoreland and the Crow Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** Barnet B. Skelton has agreed to represent the Crow Tribe's interest, through the Legislature, in the Westmorland bankruptcy.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL LEGISLATURE IN REGULAR SESSION:

That Barnet B. Skelton shall be engaged with the Crow Legislature to represent the Crow Tribe's interests in the Westmoreland bankruptcy, and

#### BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

The Speaker of the Legislature is empowered to sign the engagement letter attached to this Legislative Resolution and incorporated hereto.
