A Legislative Resolution Titled:

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBE OF INDIANS CERTIFYING IT HAS
PUBLISHED INFORMATION ABOUT THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM FOR INDIAN TRIBES AND ALASKA NATIVE
VILLAGES PURSUANT TO THE CITIZEN PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS OF
24 CFR 1003.604**

LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS:

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians is a federally recognized Tribe inhabiting the Crow Indian Reservation and possessing inherent sovereign governmental powers; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians furnished residents with information concerning the amounts of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities that may be undertaken; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians held one meeting to obtain the views of residents on community development and housing needs; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians has published a community development statement and solicited comments regarding the statement; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians afforded residents an opportunity to review and comment on the tribe's performance under any active CDBG; and

WHEREAS, the Apsáalooke Nation Housing Authority (ANHA), a tribally designated housing entity, is submitting a grant application on behalf of the Crow Tribe of Indians to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians and ANHA considered comments and views expressed by residents and, if appropriate, modified the application accordingly and made the modified application available to residents; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE:


Section1. The Crow Tribe of Indians has met the requirement for resident participation in accordance with 24 CFR 1003.604. Attached hereto and incorporated as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Legislative Resolution shall take effect upon its enactment by the Crow Tribal Legislature in accordance with the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution.


