A Legislative Resolution Titled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF LEGISLATIVE BRANCH ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") has the power and duty under Article V, Section 2 of the Crow Tribal Constitution to promulgate and adopt resolutions in accordance with the Tribal Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has determined a need resulting in the restructuring of staff serving the Senators of the Crow tribal Legislature, which has now resulted in restructuring and rebuilding much of the legislative personnel framework; and

WHEREAS, Celisa Jefferson, current Receptionist has returned from furlough status and has carried additional administrative duties including the receptionist duties since such return without proper authorization; and

WHEREAS, based upon the need to restructure the personnel framework and to ensure the Personnel Policy is properly adhered to, it is necessary and proper to combine and update the Receptionist Position with the additional duties and establish such position as "Administrative Support";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE IN SESSION,

Section 1: The position "Receptionist" is hereby eliminated, and such position shall be updated to include additional administrative duties, establishing the position of <u>Administrative</u> <u>Support</u>.

Section 2: The Administrative Assistant shall continue to be full-time, permanent staff member. The duties and qualifications of the Administrative Support shall be as provided in the attached Position Description, and the Legislative Branch Personnel Practices and Policy Manual, as updated and amended, shall fully govern the position.

A Resolution of the Crow Tribal Legislature Establishing the Position of Legislative Branch Administrative Support

Section 3. Celisa Jefferson, as current Receptionist, shall assume this newly created position as soon as practical. The Speaker of the House shall be authorized to make any such budget modification as may be required to implement the new Administrative Support duties to Ms. Jefferson's current position, including any back pay that may be owed as determined by the Speaker of the House.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon becoming duly adopted by the Legislature.
