PUBLIC NOTICE

As Speaker of the House, it is my duty to officially give notice to the Crow Tribal General Council that the Executive Branch Chairman Alvin "AJ" Not Afraid, Jr. failed to submit a complete report to the Legislative Branch for the Regular July Session 2020.

Pursuant to the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution, the Crow Tribal Executive Branch has a duty for reporting requirements in Article IV, Section 4. Included in the general duties of the Executive Branch, elected officials have a duty to provide for the fiscal management of the Executive Branch and prepare complete financial reports for the Crow Legislative Branch on a quarterly basis as well as biannual reports for the Crow Tribal General Council.

Article IV, Section 6, duties of the Executive Branch Secretary include record keeping of all actions of the Executive Branch, and to ensure proper reports, in accordance with this Constitution, are forwarded to the Crow Tribal General Council.

The Crow Tribal Fiscal Management Act, (CLB 07-08) commands the Executive Branch to report to the Crow Tribal General Council each year annually in the month of September (CLB 07-08, section. 6, A. Budget Monitoring and Control).

Legislative Resolution 10-21 ("A Resolution of the Crow Tribal Legislature to Establish Executive Branch Reporting Standards and to Enhance Reporting to the Crow Tribal General Council") explains what needs to be in the Quarterly Financial Reports from Executive Branch. Legislative Resolution 10-21 (LR 10-21 section 1. (c)) also directs the Speaker of the House to give notice to the Crow Tribal General Council regarding "no reporting" submitted or received from Chairman Alvin "A.J." Not Afraid, the Executive Branch Chief Executive Officer and to request a written explanation from the Secretary R. Knute Old Crow as to why no report was received.
