## A RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE FOR SUPPORT OF THE USDA GRANT RE-CONNECT3 FUNDING PROGRAM FOR PROJECT TELEPHONE (DBA NEMONT)

Legislative Findings:

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Crow Tribal Constitution the Crow Tribal Legislature (hereinafter "Legislature") with the power and duty to promulgate and adopt resolutions in accordance with the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Resolution 10-20 states, it shall be the policy of the Legislature that Legislative Resolutions are an expression of the voice of the elected Senators, and which is based on the inherent sovereign tribal authority of the Crow Tribal General Council, as delegated to the Legislature under the 2001 Crow Tribal Constitution; and

WHEREAS, The Legislature has the constitutional authority to provide for the establishment of Branch rules and policies governing its review of proposed legislation and other matters requiring legislative action; and

WHEREAS, Under House Rule 10(H) and Branch Policy contained in Legislative Resolution No.10-20, all proposed legislation, and legislative resolutions, by the Legislature are assigned to the appropriate Legislative Branch Committee upon introduction for review and official recommendation to the full Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch LR 10-20, section (1), states, Legislative Resolutions for final approval of an Executive Branch proposal or for the authorization of tribal action in accordance with the 2001 Crow Constitution and other applicable tribal law or federal law; and

WHEREAS, Project Telephone is requesting for funding under the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for Re-Connect3. The proposal will provide broadband deployment in remote areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Legislature fully supports the grant submission to the USDA for Project Telephone for the funded project which will aid in bringing Fiber To Doorstep for all residents within the Crow Reservation.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE IN SPECIAL SESSION

This Legislative Resolution shall take effect immediately upon being duly adopted by the Legislature.

WHEREAS the Crow Tribe Executive Chairman is duly elected to represent the Crow Tribe Nation and is empowered to act on behalf of the Crow Nation with the support and approval of the Legislature, and that all actions shall be adherent to provisions set forth in the Constitution and by-Laws, and

WHEREAS, Project Telephone Company provides telecommunications service to the Crow Tribe Nation, and

WHEREAS Project Telephone Company is applying for funding under the USDA sponsored Re-Connect Round 3 funding program, and

WHEREAS the Legislature recognizes the benefit of a USDA Re-Connect Round 3 funded project, known as the Project Telephone Company Re-Connect Round 3 Fiber to the Premise (FTTP) project, to the residents within the project area and to all residents of the Crow Tribe Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Project Telephone Company has requested endorsement from the Crow Tribe in support of Project Telephone Company Re-Connect Round 3 application, and

WHEREAS the Crow Tribe Legislature endorses the position that this project will construct facilities that essentially enhances the value of Tribal Lands it traverses, and

WHEREAS the Crow Tribe Legislature recognizes that the value to the residences of the communities of St Xavier and Fort Smith of the Crow Tribe Reservation lies in the advanced capabilities that the FTTP facilities bring, and not in the act of placing the facilities, and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Crow Tribe Executive Chairman, with support from the Legislature does hereby recommend and support the Project Telephone Company's requests.
